SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE

SPRINGPOINT SENIOR LIVING EMPLOYEE HEALTH PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of the Springpoint Senior Living Employee Health Plan, Plan Number 501, Employer Identification Number 31-1480524, for the short plan year period beginning March 1, 2020 and ending December 31, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

UNINSURED COMPONENTS

The plan sponsor, Springpoint Senior Living, Inc., has committed itself to pay certain medical, prescription drug, telemedicine, dental, vision, employee assistance program and healthcare flexible spending account claims under the terms of the plan.

INSURED COMPONENTS - INSURANCE INFORMATION

The plan had a contract with Aetna Life Insurance Co. (dental) and Metropolitan Life Insurance Company (life insurance, long-term disability, accidental death & dismemberment – reported through the NJHA Insurance Fund Welfare Plan for 2020) to pay certain claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the short plan year ending December 31, 2020 were \$197,194.

Because all components of the plan are unfunded and insured, the plan did not have any reportable plan assets and did not earn any income during the short plan year.

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. Insurance information, including sales commissions paid by the insurance carrier, is included in that report.
