Preferred Generic Program

The Preferred Generic Program is intended to encourage generic drug utilization while decreasing costs for you and for Springpoint. Your benefit plan offers a lower copay when you choose generic medication. When a brand name drug is prescribed and a generic option is available, you may still choose to have the brand name drug filled. However, in this situation you will be required to pay the difference in cost between the brand name drug and generic drug, in addition to your generic copay.

Mandatory Mail Order Program

Employees must use the mail order program for maintenance medications. Once the initial prescription and two refills are filled at the retail pharmacy, the mail order program is mandatory for coverage of the ongoing prescriptions. This means that medication will not be covered under the retail pharmacy program after the 3rd fill.

Using the mail order program for your maintenance medications will save you money. You will receive **up to a 90-day (3-month) supply** for less than the cost of three retail fills. In addition to the savings, your prescriptions will be delivered right to your home.
